Brewing Equipment - Two Brewers

The tanks cost-- they're seven barrel fermenters-- they cost about \$8,000 a piece.

The brew house was a replacement for a brew house from a company in California that we may or may not ever get any money or equipment out of them, because that all fell apart. And this was BrewFab's first brew house. They cut us a sweet deal on that. I believe we're paying just over \$13,000 for that. Normally, we'd be spending about \$35,000. And I think if BrewFab sells another one, that's what it will cost.

We work together. They're not the most brewy savvy. I'm certainly not the most fabrication savvy. But together we were able to make something.

Our equipment initially cost us around \$500,000. That included kind of all of the equipment just associated with the brewery.

We have costs with air conditioners and sinks, and things like that, that I consider more of the tasting room cost. But the brewery equipment all together, total was around \$500,000.
