The Teacher Leadership Graduate Certificate is a program that develops teachers' capacity to work with adult learners, assume informal and formal leadership roles, engage and lead teacher research, coach for student learning, mentor peers and preservice teachers, and facilitate high quality job-embedded learning at their schools.

Because this program was developed in collaboration with school district representatives, it is designed to meet teachers' and schools' needs for developing high quality teacher leaders. The certificate emphasizes exemplary teaching and connects to Domain Four of Charlotte Danielson's work and the Empowering Effective Teachers (EET) Framework.

The **Teacher Leader Graduate Certificate** prepares participants to meet the Teacher Leader Model Standards and the National Staff Development Council's standards.
